1 gallon (gal) $=4$ quarts (qt)
1 gallon (gal) $=\mathbf{2}$ half gallons
1 gallon (gal) = 8 pints (pt)
1 gallon (gal) $=16$ cup ( $\mathbf{c}$ )
1 gallon (gal) = 128 fluid ounces (floz)

1 half gallon = 2 quarts (qt)
1 quart (qt) $=2$ pints (pt)
1 quart (pt) = 32 fluid ounces ( fl oz )
1 pint (pt) = 2 cups (c)
1 cup (c) = 8 fluid ounces (floz)
1 pint (pt) = 16 fluid ounces (floz)
